**\$5 per paycheck sponsors supplies for student orientation activities in the community**

**\$10 per paycheck helps to provide dinner at the Dinner and Conversation series, which connects residents to CEC programs and services**

**\$25 per paycheck supports a week of open computer lab hours for community users**

**\$35 per paycheck opens the CEC on a Saturday for programming that serves the whole family, such as tutoring programs, computer coaching, and health and wellness sessions**

**\$60 per paycheck funds a week of tutoring in one of the neighborhood elementary schools**

**\$95 per paycheck covers one month of a Community Assistant's work to take on capacity-building projects in the neighborhood**
